
Durham Tees Valley Business Centre – Speed Awareness Course



Durham Tees Valley Business Centre, Primrose Hill Business Park, Orde Wingate Way, Stockton on Tees, TS19 0GA.

From A1 Southbound

Leave the A1 at junction 60, taking the A689 exit to Teesside/Hartlepool/Bishop Auckland. At the roundabout, take the 1st exit onto A689. Go through one roundabout, at the next taking the 2nd exit onto Stockton Rd/A177. At the roundabout, take the 2nd exit onto Durham Rd/A177. Go through 1 roundabout and at next roundabout, take the 3rd exit onto Durham Road. Turn left onto Orde Wingate Way and follow the road going to the right and venue will be on your left.

From A19 Northbound

Leave the A19 taking the A1027 exit toward Billingham/Norton. On the A1027 roundabout, take the 1st exit onto A1027. At the next roundabout, take the 2nd exit and stay on A1027. At the next roundabout take the 2nd exit onto Durham Road after half a mile turn left onto Orde Wingate Way. Follow the road going to the right and venue will be on your right.

WORKSHOP CHECKLIST

Please use this checklist to ensure you will be allowed to participate:

Upon attending the workshop you MUST produce your Driving Licence.

Please note; if you have a photocard style driving licence it must have a valid photograph (see 4b on the licence) and please bring the confirmation of booking or payment letter.

If you do not have a photocard style licence - please bring your paper driving licence AND a passport or similar photographic means of identification along with your confirmation of booking or payment letter. If you hold a non-European driving licence you must also bring your passport and any other appropriate documents showing proof of entry into the UK within the last 12 months.

Failing to produce your driving licence or evidence of your identity may result in your being refused entry onto the workshop.

- If possible, please bring any correspondence you have received from the police.
- Check your route and venue location before the day of the workshop. Please plan to arrive 15 minutes before the workshop start time. This is in order for registration to take place – late arrivals will not be allowed to participate.
- You must be appropriately dressed for the consideration of other clients no work clothes such as overalls or muddy boots, you will not be permitted and refused entry.
- Do not bring anyone with you (unless you have made prior arrangements to bring an interpreter or carer see below).

If you require any of the following you must telephone the Helpline below <u>immediately</u> (if you have not already done so) to make the necessary arrangements:

- You have difficulty understanding English and will need an interpreter. You can bring your own interpreter who must be aged at least 16 years. If you require an interpreter, we can arrange this. There will be a charge for the interpreter.
- You have hearing difficulties and require a sign language interpreter. If you require a signer, we can arrange this.
- You need to bring a carer or have special requirements due to mobility or other difficulties.
